

COOKIES POLICY

This website uses cookies, i.e. text files that are stored on the user's computer to improve website functionality, simplify navigation by automating certain procedures (such as login), and analyze the use of the website.

Cookies can be divided into two main categories: "profiling cookies" and "technical cookies".

Profiling cookies

This website does not use profiling cookies, i.e. cookies aimed at creating user profiles in order to send messages in line with the preferences expressed during browsing.

Technical cookies

The website uses technical cookies to allow safe, fast, and efficient browsing and to provide users with the requested services. The installation of such cookies does not require prior user consent.

Analytical cookies

Analytical cookies are used to collect information, in aggregated form, about the number of users and how they visit this website. The website uses the Wordpress plugin ads-WpSiteCount.

The configuration adopted, in order to exclude the processing of identifying data, collects the following information:

- IP address
- Operating system used
- Browser type

Third-party cookies

Subject to the user's consent, the website uses third-party cookies to enable translation of the website into English (plugin used: Translate AI Multilingual Solutions). When the user selects a language different from the default, some page content may be transmitted to Google servers solely for the purpose of providing the automatic translation service.

This processing may involve:

- the communication of technical browsing data (e.g. IP address, browser and device information);
- the setting of technical or preference cookies (e.g. to store the language selected by the user).

The translation service may involve the installation of third-party cookies attributable to Google, used exclusively for technical and functional purposes, such as storing the language selected by the user and ensuring the proper functioning of the translation service.

The Data Controller has no direct access to or control over cookies and data processed by Google through the Google Translate service.

The use of the Google Translate service may involve the transfer of personal data to non-EU countries, particularly to the United States. Such transfer takes place on the basis of the safeguards provided for in Articles 44 et seq. of the GDPR, as indicated by Google in its documentation.

Cookie management

To manage cookies and related consents, the Data Controller uses the consent management tool “CookieYes”, whose company acts as Data Processor (terms available at <https://www.cookieyes.com/dpa/>).

Analytical cookies are installed on the user’s device only with their consent, which may be withdrawn at any time.

Users may in any case disable cookie functions directly from their browser settings by following the instructions provided at the following links:
